Rainier Avenue North remains closed at the 900 block

It is still unknown when it will re-open

RENTON, WA – City of Renton crews have been working since Wednesday afternoon to repair a sinkhole in the 900 block of Rainier Avenue North. A detour around the affected area has been in place since 2 p.m. Wednesday.

City crews will start cleaning the road and equipment this evening and will work through the night. Temporary pavement repairs will begin early Friday morning. City of Renton crews and contractors have been working non-stop since Wednesday afternoon to repair the sinkhole.
