Whereas, many public servants—military personnel, police officers, firefighters, aid workers, health care professionals, and many others—risk their lives each day in service to our communities; and

Whereas, public servants also include teachers, doctors, scientists, nurses, safety inspectors, laborers, engineers, technicians, social workers, and countless other occupations whose services are critical at this time; and

Whereas, their tireless efforts are especially meaningful today during the COVID-19 pandemic; and

Whereas, day in and day out they continue to fulfil the normal work of government—even at personal risk and even in a global pandemic—to provide the essential services needed by our communities with efficiency and integrity. These unsung heroes do the work that keeps our city operating safely; and

Whereas, public employees commit to a cause beyond themselves to make a difference in the lives of all people and a lasting contribution to our city, state, and nation;
