CALL FOR BIDS**

N 30th St and Burnett Ave N Storm System Improvement Project, SWP-27-3716

Sealed bids will be received until 2:30 p.m., Wednesday, May 25, 2016, at the City Clerk's office, 7th floor, and will be opened and publicly read in Conference Room 511 on the 5th floor, Renton City Hall, 1055 South Grady Way, Renton WA 98057.

The work to be performed within 60 working days from the date of commencement under this contract shall include, but not be limited to:

- Construction surveying, staking, and production of as-built plans.
- Traffic control.
- Installing and maintaining adequate Temporary Erosion and Sediment Control measures.
- Installing new storm system of approximately 1,430 linear feet of 12-inch and 18-inch diameter storm sewer pipe.
- Trench excavation, including dewatering, shoring, removal of any existing unsuitable material, disposal of excavated material.
- Trench backfill with suitable material and compaction to required standards.
- Protection of existing utilities.
- Removal and burial in place of approximately 250 linear feet of abandoned asbestos cement water pipe where it conflicts or impedes the installation of new storm pipes.
- Installing 6 Type 2 - 48-inch catch basins, 2 Type 1L catch basins, 1 Type 1 catch basin and 3 concrete inlets.
- Temporary erosion control and bypass of the existing storm system flows.
- Removal and replacement of asphalt concrete pavement.
- Asphalt overlay and restoration of pavement markings.
- Potential removal of cement concrete pavement.
- Removal and replacement of concrete curbs, gutters, sidewalks, curb ramp and driveway entrances.
- Relocation of City-owned side sewers only if they conflict with the new storm system.
- Landscape and property restoration.

This project is funded in part by the King County Flood Control District. Neither King County nor any of its departments or employees are, or shall be, a party to any contract or any subcontract resulting from this solicitation for bids.

The estimated project cost is \$600,000 to \$700,000.

The City reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids and to waive any and/or all informalities. Bid documents will be available May 9, 2016. Plans, specifications, addenda, and the plan holders list for this project are available on-line through Builders Exchange of Washington, Inc., at <http://www.bxwa.com>.
