



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE
SW 7th STREET/NACHES AVENUE SW STORM SYSTEM
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – PHASE I (SWP-27-3570)

The Surface Water Utility will be constructing Phase I of the SW 7th Street/Naches Avenue SW Storm System Improvement Project to install a new 60-inch diameter outfall at an unnamed tributary to Springbrook Creek, and a new 60-inch stormwater pipe in Naches Avenue SW and SW 7th Street to Powell Avenue SW to improve conveyance capacity in the South Renton drainage basin. The project will also install 11 Filterra water quality treatment vaults from Naches Avenue SW to Lind Avenue SW to improve water quality in Springbrook Creek.

Construction is expected to **BEGIN on August 25, 2014** and is expected to be completed in **December 2014**. The work will begin in Naches Avenue SW at the outfall to the tributary to Springbrook Creek, and will progress south on Naches Avenue SW to a connection in SW 7th Street. It will then continue east on SW 7th Street to Powell Avenue SW. The last phase of the project will be the installation of the Filterra Water Quality Vaults in SW 7th Street from Naches Avenue SW to Lind Avenue SW.

Construction on Naches Avenue SW is planned between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Construction on SW 7th Street between Naches Avenue SW and Lind Avenue SW is planned between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Saturday work may occur between the hours of 7:00 am and 7:00 pm along the entire project, if needed.

Advance warning signs will be placed at major access points to SW 7th Street notifying motorists of limited access during specified times within the construction zone. The signs will also inform motorists that access to businesses along SW 7th Street will be available during construction.

Driveways may be temporarily blocked during working hours, but access will be restored by the end of each working day. The contractor, Road Construction Northwest, Inc. will notify you 24 hours in advance if construction is expected to block your driveway. You will also be notified if construction conflicts with utility service and any temporary interruption will be restored as soon as possible. Please notify the Surface Water Utility if you lose utility service during construction without prior notice.


