Dear Renton Arts Community member:

The Renton Municipal Arts Commission (RMAC) is accepting proposals for the 2009 Art Grant Program. This program provides financial support for artists and organizations that desire to initiate, organize, and promote arts and education to benefit the citizens of Renton. Through the program, RMAC seeks to provide opportunities for innovation and the development of unique services outside the scope of the Commission's existing programming. Arts disciplines include dance, drama/theatre, music, visual arts, literary arts, media arts, and performing arts.

Project funds are available annually as approved by the City Council for the RMAC. Funds available for project proposals are extremely limited; the Commission encourages project funding requests be \$1,000 or less. If funds are still available in September, there will be an additional round of funding for smaller projects (less than \$500).

- Who Can Apply:** Artists and Organizations that promote art within the Renton School District boundaries:
- Arts and Cultural organizations of all sizes, including professional and community-based groups.
  - Community groups involved in arts activities.
  - Organizations are encouraged to obtain IRS not-for-profit status [501(c)3 status], but such status is not required to receive project support funding.

- Organization mission and vision statement
- Organization primary activities
- Organization size
- Population served (in addition to performances for the general public)
- Recent past performances or exhibits in the City of Renton and the Renton School District areas
- Project description, including timeline
- Project budget and funding request
