- Be sure to check zoning regulations before you apply for a permit.
- APPLICANTS FOR BUILDING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:**
- A. Completed Building Permit Application**  
Residential only. The sub-contracting application the contractor's name and license #.
- B. Site Plan** - We strongly recommend you submit your drawings.  
Two (2) copies on 8 1/2" x 11" paper.  
\*Three (3) copies required for new construction.

- APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR INTERIM PERMIT SUBMITTALS. PLEASE CALL TO 5425 430-7276.**
- COMPLETE BUILDING PERMIT SUBMITTALS:**
1. Receipt for Construction Fee (See construction fee schedule)
  2. **3-2-2 RULE** - The applicant must submit structural, civil, landscape, and/or other professional stamps on two additional sets of drawings. One set of off-site improvement drawings and one set of electronic copy of the drawings.
  3. Where specific information is required
  4. Stress/structural drawings
  5. Storm Drainage drawings
  6. A Fill Source if appropriate









# TOTAL PROPOSED BUDGET

2017-18 Citywide Proposed Revenue & Sources \$461.5 million




2017-18 Proposed Citywide Expenditure & Uses \$476 million




# GENERAL GOVERNMENT FUND BUDGET
