- City of Renton staff will coach each team. Parent volunteers are encouraged to assist.
- Emphasis is on fun, participation, and skill development.
- Boys and girls ages 5 to 10 years old. Participants must meet minimum age at the start of program. Ages as of June 15, 2009.
- All skill levels encouraged to participate.
- Parent requests for team placement accepted, but not guaranteed.
- Teams are formed based on school attendance.
- Practices are one day a week for one hour; to be determined by Athletic Department (Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday evenings). Machine pitch teams will practice for just over an hour.
- All games are played Thursday evenings. Each team will play a 6 game schedule - one game per week and one practice per week.
- All players receive a team jersey and cap.

Season Timeline:

- Registration will remain open until the program is full. Space is limited!
- Players will be notified of practice location, day and time by email after June 5th.
- Practices begin: Week of June 15th. Days TBD: Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday.
- Games begin: July 2nd and run through August 6th. (weather permitting)
