**How do I calculate sewer charges for my non residential or multi-family property?**

First you need to determine if your water meter is read monthly or bi-monthly. You can look at the meter reading period listed above the \*graph on your statement for this information. Water meters that are read **Bi-Monthly:**

**Renton Sewer Example:**

A minimum base rate of \$16.82. This includes 15 units (7.5 per month) of water consumption. Over 15 units is billed \$1.90 per unit.  
 (1 unit=100 cubic feet=750 gallons)

20 units of water used in a one month period.

15 units included in base rate of: \$16.82

5 units at \$1.90 \$9.50
