



Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED)

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) is defined as the proper design and effective use of the built environment that can lead to a reduction in the fear and incidence of crime, and an improvement in the quality of life.

- Keep foliage cut back and away from porch areas and decks so you can easily see outside.
- Keep landscaping cut below window sill level so you're not creating hiding places for a burglar.
- Cut trees up to at least 4 feet so you can see if somebody is trying to hide behind them.



Disposing of garbage can mean different things to different people. Unless it's garbage day, and their waste management service company is very generous, this should be reported to Code Enforcement (425-430-7373).



There are many opportunities for you to help deter criminal activity in your neighborhood. One of them is to report graffiti markings to utility or real estate companies. Don't let these displays remain in your neighborhood. It tends to attract, and spread, additional graffiti from rival groups.
