GUIDELINES

Application

- This application is for youth 18 or younger and Adults over the age of 50. There is a separate application for the Adaptive Recreation Program, for more information call 425-430-6748
- Applications are valid for the calendar year
- If Gift of Play funds are available the scholarship/subsidy will be awarded on a first come, first served basis if eligible
- Only one (1) application is required per family for the calendar year
- Applications are available online at rentonwa.gov/GiftofPlay and at any of these locations; Renton Community Center, Renton Senior Activity Center, and Highlands Neighborhood Center

Income Guidelines

- Qualifying incomes follow the [USDA Child Nutrition Program Income Guidelines](#) which are the same as the Renton School District Free and Reduced Meal guidelines

Eligibility

- Youth up to 18 years old and adults over the age of 50
- City of Renton residents that reside within the Renton School District boundary or attend a Renton School
- Membership passes for Fitness and Henry Moses Aquatic Center **do not** qualify under this program

Awarded Amount

- Approved applications will be awarded an annual scholarship/subsidy amount of \$75 for each qualifying individual
- The awarded scholarship/subsidy funds will be added to each qualifying individual's City of Renton recreation account
- The awarded scholarship/subsidy funds can be used on one program or can be spread out between multiple programs throughout the calendar year if desired.
- Unspent funds **do not** roll over to the next calendar year
