Playing With Fire!

Ages 14 and up, minors must be accompanied by an adult. Playing with fire is generally not advised, but in this class that is exactly what we will do! After learning the basics of fire science, types of extinguishers and home fire safety in the classroom, we will go out to the fire training grounds and play with fire. This is a hands-on class to experiment with different types and sizes of fire extinguishers. Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)

Age 16 and up, 16–18 must be accompanied by an adult. In most disasters, survivors provide the first immediate assistance to those in need. CERT teaches you how to respond when others look to you for help. Are you ready? Learn skills like disaster first aid, fire suppression, light search and rescue, terrorism response, disaster psychology, and more! This class is a combination of lecture and hands on training to get you ready to help yourself and others during an emergency. Mental Health First Aid

Ages 18 and up. You might know how to do CPR or the Heimlich Maneuver, but did you know you are more likely to encounter someone experiencing a mental health crisis than in need of physical first aid? This class teaches you to give the initial help to a person showing symptoms of mental illness or in a mental health crisis until appropriate professional or other help can be engaged. Topics covered include severe depression, psychosis, panic attacks, substance abuse, and suicidal thoughts and behaviors. Amateur Radio (Ham) Licensing Class

Ages 13 and up, minors must be accompanied by an adult. Amateur radio, often called ham radio, is both a hobby and a service in which participants called “hams” use various types of radio equipment to communicate with other radio amateurs for recreation and public service. This course covers all of Element 2 of the FCC Amateur Radio Service materials. Participants will be fully prepared to take the Technician Class licensing exam, which will be administered at the end of day two. After passing the exam, you will receive your amateur radio license by mail from the FCC. A \$40 fee payable to the instructor covers the manual and exam fee. **Held at Renton Regional Fire Authority Fire Station #14, 1900 Lind Ave SW.**

GENERAL REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- All financial transactions end 30 minutes prior to closing of building.
- Pre-registration is required for all classes unless otherwise noted. Washington State sales tax will be added to applicable programs and rental fees.
- Classes are held at a variety of locations. Site locations can be found in the Facilities Locations section on the next page.
- Supply fees are additional fees paid directly to the instructor for items not included in the class fee or provided by the City of Renton Community Services Department.
- This recreation brochure is published for informational purposes only and is subject to change without notice. Every effort is made to ensure accuracy at the time of publication.
- Register early to ensure that the program you desire isn't filled or canceled due to below minimum enrollment.

Resident Discount Rate

The City of Renton recognizes people living within Renton's city limits support, through their city taxes, the City of Renton's Community Services Department. Because of this, the City of Renton offers those living inside the city limits a discount on programs and facility rental fees. People who reside outside the city limits are welcomed and encouraged to enjoy the activities and services the City of Renton provides. The resident discount fee is the first fee listed. You can verify your home address is within the City limits or with in unincorporated King County at Rentonwa.gov/addresslocator.

Withdrawal & Refund Guidelines

- Refund requests must be made in writing to be eligible for a refund.
- If a request is made after the program has already begun (with the exception of program satisfaction), no refunds will be issued.

Adult Leagues

No refunds will be issued to athletic teams, for league play or tournament play, if the request is made after schedules have been completed.

Classes, Trips & Programs

- More than seven days before start date:
The refunded/credited amount will be the program fee.
- Seven days or less before start date:
No refund will be issued.
- Canceled by the City of Renton:
Full refund.

PLEASE NOTE: Special refund requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis. If you withdraw due to special circumstances, the refund amount will be determined by the program coordinator.
