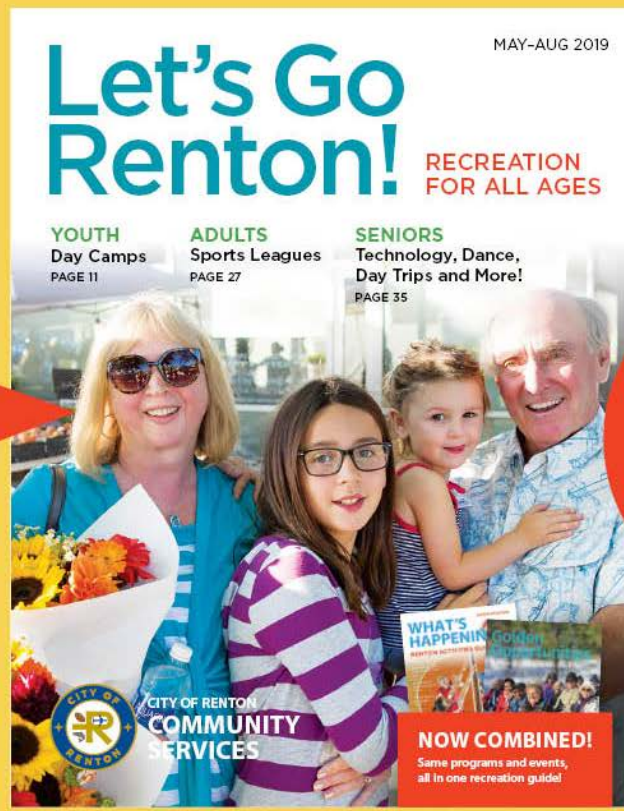

New Recreation Guide available

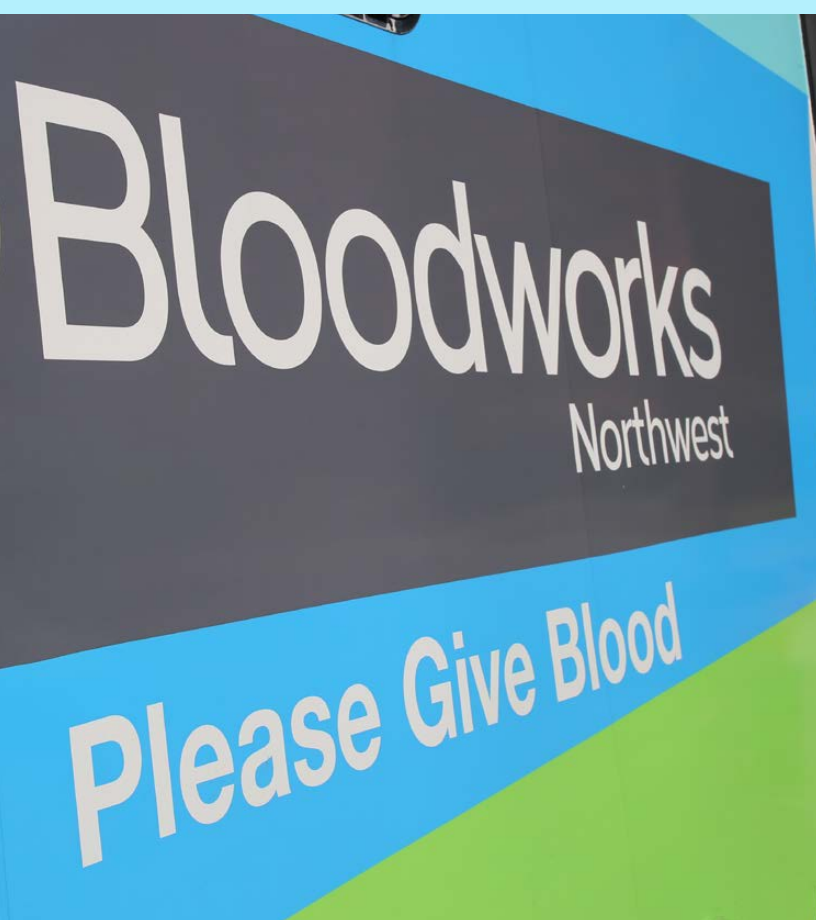
