Be part of Renton River Days July 21-23

Clear your calendars and plan to experience Renton River Days July 21-23. Renton's annual family festival and community celebration returns to its pre-COVID three-day run of familiar family-friendly events, plus exciting new ones.

Back this year, are activities for all ages at Liberty Park, the parade, rubber ducky derby, pancake breakfast, food trucks, community booths, and musical stage entertainment.

New activities for 2023 are the activity zone, summer bazaar, basketball (3-on-3) and volleyball tournaments, swim sessions, a poker walk/pub crawl, and a drone show on Friday night at Piazza Park.

The Activity Zone will be open 11 a.m.

to 8 p.m. on Friday and Saturday and 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Sunday. The Zone will have fee-based and free activities for everyone. Pre-purchase wristbands for fee-based activities at rentonwa.gov/register. Use the keyword "Zone." Wristbands are \$10 daily or \$25 for three days.

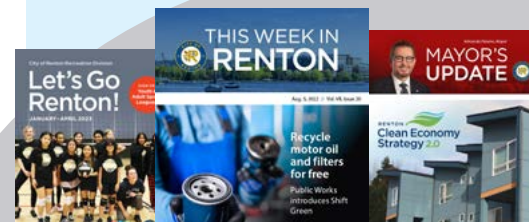
