RENTON, WA – The second annual Pacific Northwest Diversity Career Fair will be held Tuesday, September 10, 2019, from 4 to 7 p.m. at the [Renton Pavilion Event Center](#). Job-seekers are asked to [pre-register](#).

The fair provides an excellent opportunity to meet with public-sector employers from around the area. Over three dozen employers will be on hand, including the cities of Renton, Auburn, Bellevue, Issaquah, Seattle, Tukwila, the Port of Seattle, Census Bureau, Valley Communications Center, Pierce County and several state of Washington departments.

The event will also feature expert speakers from WorkSource, the Seattle Housing Authority, Washington State Department of Enterprise Services and the City of Seattle’s Department of Human Resources. Attendees can bring their resume and have it reviewed by experts.
