Human Services Committee seeks to fill three vacancies

Committee helps develop policies to support residents and the community

RENTON, WA – The City of Renton's [Human Services Advisory Committee](#) (HSAC) is accepting applications for three vacant positions.

Committee members assist staff in developing policies designed to support Renton residents and the community. The mayor, Renton City Council, and staff review its recommendations before making funding decisions on programs and projects.

The committee comprises 11 members who must live within the Renton city limits. The membership includes one youth member, who must be under 21. That position is also open. The individuals on the committee represent the city's diverse nature, including geography, gender, age, and ethnicity. The mayor appoints members to three-year terms or to fill the remainder of an existing term.

The Human Services Advisory Committee meets monthly on the third Tuesday at 3 p.m. Meetings are hybrid and may be attended in person or remotely.

Applications are online at rentonwa.gov/application, with the first review on Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2022. The final application deadline is 5 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 30, 2022.
