# Boat Launch

# Welcome to the City of Renton Boat Launch

Please help all boaters enjoy the day by reviewing and following these rules and courtesy guidelines.





- **1. RAMP AREA** The ramp area is for launching and retrieving boats only. No docking except immediately after launching and immediately prior to retrieving your boat.
- 2. ORDER OF PICK UP When retrieving or launching your boat, the order is formed by vehicles lined up with trailers, not by boats in the water.
- 3. TRAFFIC FLOW Follow directions on posted signs and understand the established launching and retrieval traffic flow patterns before using the launch.
- 4. ATTENDANT If there is an attendant on duty, follow their directions to ensure the safe and efficient use of the launch ramp.



- **1. PREPARING** Prepare your boat before approaching the ramp area. Load all gear while in the staging lanes. Do not block the ramp.
- 2. LAUNCH & RETRIEVE If possible, use two people to launch and retrieve the boat: one to operate the tow vehicle and one to operate the boat.
- 3. PASSENGERS Encourage passengers to wait ashore while launching. Do not congregate on the docks.
- 4. CLEAR THE AREA After launching, move your boat and tow vehicle away from the launch area as soon as possible.
- 5. PARKING Vehicles without trailers must not occupy parking spaces designated for trailers.
- **6. DEPARTING** After retrieving your an area away from the ramp.
