



Veterans Memorial Park Policy

1. The Veterans Memorial Park facility is identified as a Monument.
2. This facility is excluded from the current Park Memorials and Plaque Policy.
3. Dedication tiles (6" x 6") will recognize veterans who honorably served the United States of America in one of the recognized branches of the United States military.
4. Each 6" x 6" tile recognizes one individual.
5. Individuals being recognized must have an assigned DD214 or DN204 number or other acceptable verification of service.
6. It is not required that the individual being recognized be a City of Renton resident.
7. Tile Application Forms shall be completed and submitted for approval and installed as space allows.
8. Groups or group tiles are not allowed.
9. Graphics are not allowed on the tiles.
10. Each 6" x 6" tile has three (3) lines with a maximum of sixteen (16) spaces per line.
11. Information on the tiles will be generally limited to any combination of the following information: the individual's name (typically the birth name), branch of service, rank, medals and honors, and dates of service.
12. The engraving for tiles purchased will be done on-site on a quarterly or semi-annual basis, depending upon the quantity of engravings to be performed.
13. All tiles become the property of the City and are subject to the laws, policies and procedures that govern all City property.
14. The 6" x 6" dedication tiles will be the only type of recognition at the Veterans Memorial Park, with the exception of the following: WWI Plaque, Park Dedication Plaque, and the Major Donor Tile.
15. Monetary contributions will be accepted. Significant monetary contributions are those contributions of \$1,000 and above.
16. The names of those individuals and corporations making significant monetary contributions will be identified on the Major Donor Tile to be installed at a designated location on the wall.
17. The Parks and Recreation Department will maintain the tiles at a level that is within the reasonable scope of current park operations and consistent with the maintenance of other similar park properties.
18. No other form of dedication items will be accepted, including, but not limited to, benches, trees, drinking fountains, flagpoles, trash receptacles, etc.
