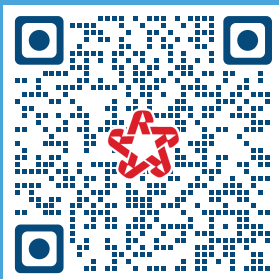

- ✓ Extras may be collected in securely tied plastic bags and clearly labeled as "trash" (max. 60 lbs.) Fees apply for each extra 15-gallon unit of garbage.

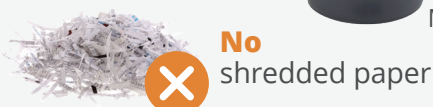
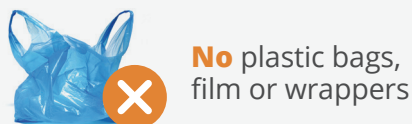
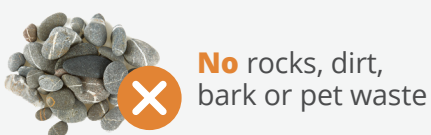


## Food-Soiled Paper/Papel con manchas de comida



Available Cart Sizes: 32-Gallon, 64-Gallon, 96-Gallon

- ✓ Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are OK
- ✓ Extras may be placed in paper lawn bags, boxes or cans clearly labeled "yard waste". Untreated wood/branches may be bundled with natural twine (max is 4 ft. x 2 ft.) No food scraps in extra containers.





# Batteries & Bulk Waste

Call **206.777.6440** to schedule a curbside collection.  
**DO NOT put these items in your cart.**



Fluorescent bulbs and tubes  
(put bulbs in sealed, clear bags; wrap tubes in paper, secure with tape and label "fluorescent tubes")



Batteries: alkaline, button and rechargeable (put rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries into separate, sealed, clear bags)

**FREE:** Call **206.777.6440** to schedule a collection



Rigid plastics: 5-gallon buckets, PVC pipe, plastic lawn furniture, coolers, plastic laundry baskets, etc.



Small household appliances



Large scrap metal  
(all metal; no coating or grease)



Wood waste, untreated and unpainted (place in cardboard box and label "wood waste")

**FEE-BASED:** Call **206.777.6440** to schedule a collection



Large appliances: fridges, dryers, ovens, water heaters,



Bulky items: mattresses, couches, furniture, etc.

## Additional Information

**Clean Sweep:** Schedule one free extra garbage collection per year. Visit [RepublicServicesRenton.com](http://RepublicServicesRenton.com) for details.

**Rate Discounts:** Get 50% off your rate if you are at least 61 years old or disabled, and your household income qualifies. Visit [RentonWA.gov/utilitybilling](http://RentonWA.gov/utilitybilling) to apply.

**Carry-Out Service:** Free cart carry-out service is available if no one at your home can take carts to the curb. Fee-based service is available to all other customers.

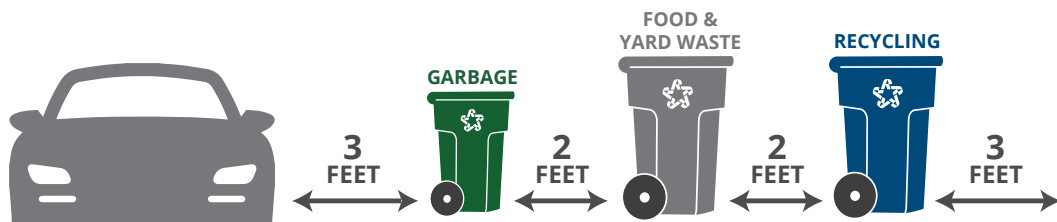

# Cart Placement

Put carts out by 7 a.m. Do not block cars, mailboxes, sidewalks or roadways. Carts must be 2' apart and at least 3' from cars, bushes, mailboxes, etc. with at least 14' of overhead clearance. Place carts as close to the curb as possible, no further than 5' from the curb. Set carts out with the handle towards the house. Remove carts as soon as possible after collection.

## Weather Delays

If weather conditions prevent the safe collection of your carts, they will be collected on Saturday. Food and yard waste will be collected on your next service day.



# 2025 Calendar (Set Out Carts by 7 a.m.)

Set carts out with handles facing the house. Do not block cars, mailboxes, sidewalks or driveways. Remove carts as soon as possible after collection.

**Holidays** - No service on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. If collection falls on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day, collection is one day later, including Saturday service for Friday customers.

**Food and Yard Waste and Recycling and Garbage Week** - During green weeks, place all carts curbside (food and yard waste, recycling and garbage).

**Food and Yard Waste** - During gray weeks, place only your food and yard waste cart curbside.

**Holiday Tree Pickup:** During the first 2 weeks of January, place un-decorated and un-flocked holiday trees next to your carts for pickup and no charge. Trees must be 6' or shorter.
