

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Will Rogers-Wiley Post Memorial Seaplane Base Maintenance Dredging Project

The Renton Airport has contracted with American Construction to dredge Lake Washington around the seaplane docks and seaplane launch ramp starting on **Monday, December 2, 2013**.

This project will significantly increase water depths around the docks and the launch ramp at the seaplane base.

The project's official end date is Wednesday, January 15, 2013, though it may conclude as early as December 21, 2013.

Construction will occur up to six days per week (Monday – Saturday) from 12:00 P.M. until 10:00 p.m. each day.

Since the equipment used to dredge the lake includes a 160' crane, runway and seaplane base use will be restricted during construction hours only.

AIRPORT OPERATIONAL IMPACTS

Specifically, during construction each day from 12:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.:

1. Runway 16 will be closed to **landings** only from 12:00 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. (will be available for departures)
2. Runway 34 will be closed to **departures** only from 12:00 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. (will be available for landings)
3. Runway 16/34 will be completely closed from 4:30 p.m. until 10:00 p.m.
4. Instrument approaches will be affected
5. All W36 docks will be closed
6. The W36 launch ramp will be closed

We will do everything possible to balance the need for runway access with completing the project on time and on budget. **Please check NOTAMS closely as they may change on a day to day basis.**
