_____ I understand that I am responsible for any guests that I may bring onto the airfield for the entire duration of their time on the airfield.

_____ I understand that this gate card will expire on the same day my driver's license expires. I also understand that if I don't use my access card within the preceding 365 days that it will be suspended.
