



March / April 2012

There were 31 residential burglaries during the month of March, with 0 occurring at an active Block Watch residence. And – there were 22 residential burglaries during the month of April, with 1 occurring at an active Block Watch residence.

I'm pleased to see a slight reduction in residential burglaries for the last couple months. With the warmer weather months coming up I expect this number to climb back up again. Below is a safety feature that I've recently come across. I witnessed the installation of this device at a community meeting recently, and was impressed with how easy it was to install. In my opinion, this goes a few steps above simply installing 3" wood screws and a latch guard.



The Door Sentinel Door Jamb Plate is 14 gauge cold rolled steel. The plate is 27" long and 1-7/8" wide. The actual thickness of the plate is just over 1/16". It comes with a white powder coat finish for years of wear and tear. It is designed to fit lock spreads from 3-1/2" all the way to 23".

The standard holes allow for lock spreads of 3-3/4" to 7-3/4" without using the punch out tabs. The kit comes with (9) 3-1/2" screws (white heads) to install the reinforcement plate to the door jamb and into the wall stud. The kit also includes (6) 3-1/2" yellow zinc screws to secure the hinge plates to the wall stud by replacing two of the smaller standard screws in each hinge. The holes are counter sunk to allow the screws to sit flush and they are offset and backset to ensure that they engage the wall stud. VOLUNTEER PARK RANGERS PROGRAM

The city has increased patrols in city parks and trails and has been enforcing a new ordinance that gives city staff and police officers the ability to expel individuals from all city parks if they engage in unlawful or inappropriate behavior. In addition, the city has implemented reduced speed limits, trail striping, signage and a comprehensive trail education and etiquette program. Last year, the city rolled out a Park and Trails Rangers program, where volunteer rangers patrol the city's parks and the Cedar River trail. Their tasks include patrolling the trails and parks to monitor the surroundings, provide information on trail and park safety, educate patrons on the rules and regulations, serving as a liaison with the community and helping to deter criminal activity with their presence



FRAUD BY DECEPTION



There are groups of individuals traveling throughout South King County who are targeting senior citizens with a vehicle repair scam. The suspects approach senior citizen in a grocery store parking lot, gas station, at their home, etc. It is possible the suspects are even damaging the victim vehicle in order to repair them. In one case, the suspects sprayed an unknown black substance on the victim's vehicle without the victim's permission, then demanded payment for the "repair". To foster credibility, the suspects may state they work for a local car dealership or body shop and explain they have extra materials they can use at a discounted rate. Remember: if it sounds too good to be true – it probably is!

Prepare and prevent, don't repair and repent.
